Birthday/Pool Party Information Sheet & Rental Agreement Contract Abington Swim Club shall be available for use by the public on a reservation basis subject to the conditions outlined on pages 2 and 3.

The purpose of these guidelines is to establish standard procedures for administering the policy and to ensure fairness in the letting of the facility. The applicant granted the reservation agrees to read and abide by the following:

PARTY PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. Pool party hosts may come no more than thirty (30) minutes before starting time to set up. No confetti is allowed in the pool area.
2. No one may enter the water before the Lifeguards have given permission. Swimming starts at a designated time and NOT earlier.
3. Deck activities, games and/or toys must be PRE-APPROVED and finalized by an Abington Swim Club Board Member or Lifeguard 5 days in advance of the party.
4. Parents are to supervise their child/children at all times.
5. Children ages 3 and under must be accompanied by an adult in the water.
6. We reserve the right to refuse the pool to anyone who doesn't conduct themselves in a safe manner or not conform to the pool safety rules we have set here and on the reverse side of this agreement.
7. The host will be held accountable for leaving the premises clean.
8. Any property damage will be the responsibility of the host. Our pool rules have been set up for your safety and for the well being of you and your guests. Please see that your guests are made aware of these safety rules, as you are ultimately responsible for the actions and the conduct of those you have chosen to attend your party on our premises.

AUTHORITY OF LIFE GUARDS

The lifeguards have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations and are empowered to impose on-the-spot penalties that may be necessary. Serious and/or repeated violations will be reported to the Abington Swim Club Board and legal authorities for additional actions as deemed necessary.

A. General Pool Rules

1. All users of the pool must conduct themselves in a courteous manner at all times which will insure the safety of other swimmers. Absolutely no abusive language, boisterous conduct, loud or offensive music or breach of peace will be tolerated.
2. Abington Swim Club and its agents are not responsible for articles brought into or left on premises by members and/or guest. Belongings left will be discarded weekly.
3. Each member has the responsibility to see that there is no littering or vandalism on pool property.
4. All members, including guests, shall use the pool at their own risk. Abington Swim Club Board, employees and/or its agents assume no responsibility for any accident or injury or damage to any person or their property resulting from such use.
5. Member and guest are requested to drive 5 mph in the parking lot and no more than the posted speed throughout the community.
6. Only pool employees and authorized personnel are allowed in the concession area, storage room, or filter room.
7. Bicycles are to be parked in the bicycle racks only. They may not be parked near the front doors or on the walkways.
8. All swimmers, including guest, will wear swimsuits. No cut-off jeans or slacks will be allowed in the pool.
9. Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool. Cloth swim diapers are REQUIRED for all children that are not potty trained. NO EXCEPTIONS!
10. Any property of the pool broken or damaged by a member or guest shall be paid for promptly by such member. No person shall take any article belonging to the pool.

B. Safety in and around Pool Complex

1. The following rules will be enforced inside the fenced pool area, including the pool building:
 - No rough or boisterous conduct
 - No running on or around the pool area
 - No wrestling or horseplay
 - No pushing or dunking of other swimmers
 - No imitating a drowning person
 - No bicycles, scooters, skates or skateboards
 - No spitting or chewing gum in the pool
2. There will be a 10 minute rest period called at 10 minutes before every hour for all swimmers under the age of 18 years of age. The 10 minute period will begin when ALL swimmers under 18 have left the water. It is the responsibility of the individuals in questions to submit proof of age to the lifeguards.
3. Absolutely NO GLASS containers or breakable objects of any kinds allowed in the pool area.
4. No one other than authorized personnel shall be permitted on the lifeguard stands. There will be no unnecessary conversation with the lifeguards while they are on duty.
5. No swimming accessories such as "fins" will be allowed in the pool except when approved and under strict supervision by the pool staff/parents.
6. No alcoholic beverages or persons under the influence or disorderly conduct will be allowed on the premises. No smoking or vaping, except in the parking lot. No drugs or anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be allowed on the premises at any time.
7. No lounge chairs will be allowed within five feet of the pool rim.
8. Flotation devices will be allowed in the big pool based on pool occupancy as determined by the lifeguards. Small children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who remains within arms reach of the child.
9. Children under the age of 12 years of age are not allowed at the pool unless in the care of a person at least 16 years of age.
10. Children ages 12 – 15 may come to the pool without an adult but may not bring guests or be accompanied by anyone under the age of 12, member or nonmember.
11. No guest will be admitted unless with a pool member who is 16 years of age or older.

C. Diving Board Rules

1. Only one person is allowed on the board at a time.
2. Only one person is allowed on the ladder at a time.
3. Only one bounce or spring is allowed.
4. Divers shall enter the water straight off the board, not toward the side.
5. Swimming in the diving area is NOT allowed when the board is in use.
6. All swimmers are responsible for exhibiting safe conduct on and around the board.
7. No floatation devices allowed in the diving area or on the board.

Rental of the Clubhouse ONLY (During Off-Season)

1. No persons will be allowed on the pool deck due to safety reasons during the off-season.
2. Host may use the refrigerator and freezer for food but must take leftovers with them.
3. Host is responsible for cleaning up after the party. Trash must be taken with the host during the off-season (the dumpster is not in use during this time).
4. The bathroom doors must remain open for our pool members from the outside door but we can post a sign on the doors coming into the pool house asking them not to disturb the host and their guest.
5. Host may decorate the room for their function, however, items are not to be hung on the wall that will cause damage (no nails, tape, anything that will remove paint or leave holes).
6. Any property damage will be the responsibility of the host. Our pool rules have been set up for your safety and for the well being of you and your guests. Please see that your guests are made aware of these safety rules, as you are ultimately responsible for the actions and the conduct of those you have chosen to attend your party on our premises.
